14. 13:00	Dispute between CPR and TCRC-LE-W concerning a 30 day suspension to B.D. for booking sick on call, and for booking unfit on 2 separate occasions. (COUNSEL)
15. 14:00	Dispute between CPR and TCRC-LE-W concerning the dismissal of M.C. for conduct unbecoming as evidenced by the use of profanities and verbal abuse towards a Company Officer, further in violation of his return to work agreement. (COUNSEL)
16. 15:00	Dispute between CPR and TCRC-LE-E concerning the dismissal of X for conduct unbecoming an employee for engaging in the use of illegal and prohibited substance (cocaine) as evidence by a positive test conducted. (COUNSEL)
